The premises should be inspected periodically for mosquito breeding places and all measures should be taken to keep the premises mosquito free.

6. 'No Smoking' board should be displayed at prominent places with in the premises.

7. Sale of Tobacco products should not be permitted within the premises.

- 8. Any occurrence of Communicable disease should be notified to the Public Health Department immediately.
- Necessary building plan approval, Form D license and Stability Certificate should be obtained from the competent authority.

10. Adequate Hand Washing facilities with soap and water to be provided at the entry of the School.

11. Wearing of face mask and social distance should be strictly followed with in the campus.

12. SOP regarding COVID-19 prevention and control activities to be strictly followed without any omission

13. The Certificate issued is liable to be cancelled at any time on infringement of any of the above said conditions and for improper maintenance of sanitation, improper maintenance of the buildings as well as urinals and toilets in the building.

14. This Certificate is valid for one year from the date of issue.
